Referencing involves inserting brief details, usually the items authors last name and year of publication within round brackets, e.g. (Neville, 2009) or Neville (2009), at the appropriate point in your text and full details of the item in a reference list at the end of your work.

The APA 6th Style manual specifies the following for the reference list. The word References should appear in bold in upper and lower case and be centred at the top of the page. All reference entries should be double-spaced. All references should be in a " hanging indent " format. (This means that the first line of each reference is flush against the left margin and the subsequent lines of each reference are indented).
