"Ulysses" was written in 1833 by Alfred Lord Tennyson, the future Poet Laureate of Great Britain. In October of 1833, Alfred Tennyson learned of the untimely death of his close friend and Arthur Henry Hallam. Hallam's death devastated Tennyson; seventeen years later he wrote a long poem about it called In Memoriam. In the immediate aftermath of the tragedy, however, he wrote "Ulysses." You might have heard of Ulysses, or Odysseus, as he is called in Homer ' s Odyssey, the epic poem that narrates his long (10 years!) journey home from the the Trojan War.

Ulysses, by Alfred Lord Tennyson, was penned in blank verse. The poem ' s persistent iambic pentameter has intervallic spondees. It slows down the pace and movement of the poem. Therefore, the laboring language reflects the stagnation that had set in the life of Ulysses. Some scholars consider Tennyson ' s Ulysses to be a dramatic monologue. However, certain critics maintain that it is a soliloquy as it does not adhere to all the constraints of the dramatic monologue.
